S IS FOR
SEEK

Medical help early
for persistent symptoms.



I IS FOR
EYE

White spot in the eye, new squint,
new blindness, bulging eyeball.



L IS FOR
LUMP

Abdomen and pelvis, head and
neck, limbs, testes and glands.



U IS FOR
UNEXPLAINED

Prolonged fever over two weeks,
loss of weight, fatigue, easy bruising
or bleeding.



A IS FOR
ACHING

Bones, joints, back and
easy fractures.



N IS FOR
NEUROLOGICAL
SIGNS

Change in behaviour, balance,
walk, milestones. Headaches
with early morning vomiting.

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
